

Hello everyone!

My name is James Lucchesi and I will be overseeing Parks & Recreation summer camps this year. Welcome to Action Squad! Your site director will be Eric Tudino and Action Squad will be located at McKinley Elementary School. He was involved in Fairfield Parks and Recreation Action Squad camp the past year and is so excited to be starting off his second year. This session is filled with so many fun on-site activities, themed days, and field trips. Something for everyone! Below will be all the information you need to know regarding all field trips (waivers, timing, etc), on-site activities, and some information to help you feel more comfortable with what's to come for Action Squad Camp 2026!

Important information regarding session in general:

1. Please send your child a snack and packed lunch each day! Please note we do not have any refrigeration on site.
 2. Please always send your children with a water bottle. There are water fountains around the building where children are able to fill up empty bottles.
 3. If your children need sunscreen, make sure it is applied before coming to camp as **counselors are not permitted to apply sunscreen to the camper.**
 4. Please write names on water bottles, lunch boxes, and other personal items so they don't get mixed up or lost!
 5. Before camp and throughout the summer I urge you to please do your best to have a conversation with your children about coming to camp and playing and behaving in a safe and respectful manner while on site, on field trips, and while on buses
 6. Make sure to remind your children that all electronic devices should be away at all times. If they're being used, camp won't be as much fun! Your children are responsible for anything they bring to camp.
 7. Please make sure that your children always wear socks and sneakers! In the event that children want to run around, we'd like to make sure they are as safe as possible!
 8. Your children will receive a Parks and Rec field trip T-Shirt. Please make sure they wear their trip shirts on every field trip!
 9. Personal toys from home are strongly discouraged. Many times, issues arise over other campers unintentionally losing/breaking personal items. We'd like to avoid this as much as possible. There are more than enough toys and activities at camp for campers to use and be thoroughly entertained.
 10. HAVE FUN!!! This camp is designed to ensure that your child has the time of their lives so never forget this rule!
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- EARLY CARE and AFTER CARE will be inside the gym and cafeteria. Doors will be propped open at 7:30AM until 5:00PM so you can see where pick up/drop off for early/after care is!

- During pick up and drop, campers must check out with their counselors before leaving the group and going home. Location for this will be at the door by the playground in the front of the school
- Campers must also check in with their counselors each morning before joining the group. On the first day, campers will be told which counselor in their group they should report to get signed in for each morning.
- Please touch base with your child's counselors each day to let them know who will be picking up that day, hear any announcements or reports, or if there are any changes in your schedule.

Here is a list of the activities that will be going on throughout the session:

Session 1 Schedule Breakdown

Monday, June 22nd - First Day of Camp!!!!!!

Remember to bring in all forms and give them to your child's counselor. Make sure to pack a lunch and a snack along with a water bottle. We will be outside and running around having fun all day so please send your child to camp with comfortable footwear and apply sunscreen before the camp day begins. Counselors are not allowed to apply sunscreen to any campers so make sure it is applied before camp starts. Camp shirts will be given to each camper before pick up at 3:00pm.

Tuesday, June 23rd- Costume day!

Wear your best costume to camp!

Wednesday, June 24th - Brownstone!

Please make sure campers wear their camp shirts. Shirts must stay on at all times even when in the lake. We will depart at 9:30 and return at 2:30. Campers may pack lunch and snack or choose to purchase lunch on site.

Thursday, June 25th– Inflatables!

Giant Inflatables will be set up on the field where the kids will be able to race and jump around with their friends on different types of fun Inflatables!

Friday, June 26th – Water Day!

Please send your child with a bathing suit, a towel, a change of clothes, and shoes they are comfortable getting wet in. They are permitted to bring water toys, but please make sure, they're labeled with the child's name and stored somewhere they won't be lost.

Monday, June 29th - Pizza Day!

At lunch your child will be given two slices of cheese pizza! We still have snack on Pizza Day so make sure to pack a snack. We can only give each child two slices so if that is not enough food then feel free to pack them an extra lunch. If your child has any allergies, please reach out to me (contact info at the bottom of the Parent Letter) so accommodations can be made.

Tuesday, June 30th – Bounce Xtreme!

Please make sure your children wear their camp shirts! We will leave at 10:00am. We will return at around 12:30pm. Campers will enjoy an action-packed day at Bounce Xtreme, where they can jump, climb, and explore a variety of exciting attractions in a safe, supervised environment. Wednesday, July 1st– Extreme Foam Sports!

A nerf war will be set up where campers will compete against each other to see who the last team standing is!

Thursday, July 2nd- Tie Dye Day!

Please remember to send your child to camp with a plain white t-shirt or any plain white item so that they can participate in our tie-dye extravaganza! Please write your child's name with a sharpie on the back label of the shirt and send it in a zip lock bag.

Friday, July 3rd – Quassy!

Quassy [IMPORTANT PLEASE READ]

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL QUASSY PERMISSION SLIPS ARE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, JUNE 26th , 2026. (We will still need a permission slip if your child is going with you or not going at all!) Here is a link to the Quassy Permission Slip: [Click here for Quassy Permission Slip](#)

1. If YOU are taking YOUR child to Quassy please find Eric to sign out your child's ticket! Parents will be able to purchase their tickets down at the recreation department.
2. If your child is coming to Quassy WITH camp, they must be dropped off at 9:00 AM at McKinley. Buses will be leaving at 9:45 AM and will be returning around 5:00 PM!
3. Your child's camp t-shirt must be worn that day if he or she is coming with the camp. If you choose to take your child to Quassy separately, please make sure they are NOT wearing their camp t-shirts. We want to make sure we know which kids to keep track of.
4. Lunch will be provided at Quassy free of charge! There is a buffet of hotdogs, hamburgers and French fries!
5. EARLY CARE WILL STILL BE HELD AT McKinley BUT THERE IS NO AFTER CARE
6. We will have access to the water park, so your children can wear their bathing suits, but they must keep their camp shirts (and shorts) on at all times. Please remember to pack extra dry clothes with your child that day so they don't have to walk around the park wet after going in the waterpark.
7. Your child should bring a bag containing dry clothes, a towel, a water bottle, and (if you choose) extra money). There are water fountains throughout the park where your child can refill if he or she gets thirsty throughout the day.

*** PARENTS/GUARDIANS NEED TO SIGN OUT TICKETS FROM DIMITRI IF THEY ARE TAKING THEIR CHILDREN TO QUASSY. FAMILY AND FRIENDS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO SIGN OUT TICKETS FOR A CHILD THAT IS NOT THEIRS. ***

Pick Up/Drop Off Forms:

Summer School:

If your child is attending a summer school program while attending our camp it is very helpful to let myself and your child's counselors know which days and times this will occur. In addition, if they are going to or being dropped off at our site to and from summer school by bus any information you have about the times of these events is helpful as well so we can do our best to expect and receive them in a timely manner. This being said, please regularly check the camp schedule for dates where we have off site field trips and their times as well will not be able to receive children from summer school until we return. For further questions please come speak to Site Director Eric.

One last tip: Throughout the session please be more receptive to answering unknown calls you may get (especially from CT area codes) as it might be one of our counselors or myself trying to reach you if there happens to be a problem or emergency with your child. This helps us gain contact with you as soon as possible!
